On January 3, 2008, Schraders Automotive 314 E. Market Street, Warsaw, reported a burglary that occurred sometime during the night.

Schraders Automotive was opening for business when an employee discovered an unknown suspect(s) had used a prying instrument on an exterior door prying it open to gain entry into the business. Once inside, the suspect(s) removed an undisclosed amount of currency from the cash register and the office area. The adjoining business, J & P's Machine Shop also had currency missing during the burglary. Believe the Suspect(s) exited the building through J & P's Machine Shop.
